THE 2021 THEME IS "TRAVEL THE WORLD TOGETHER".

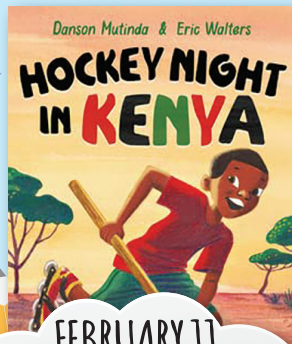
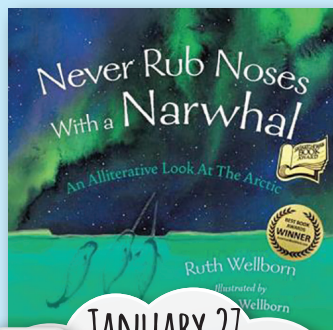
